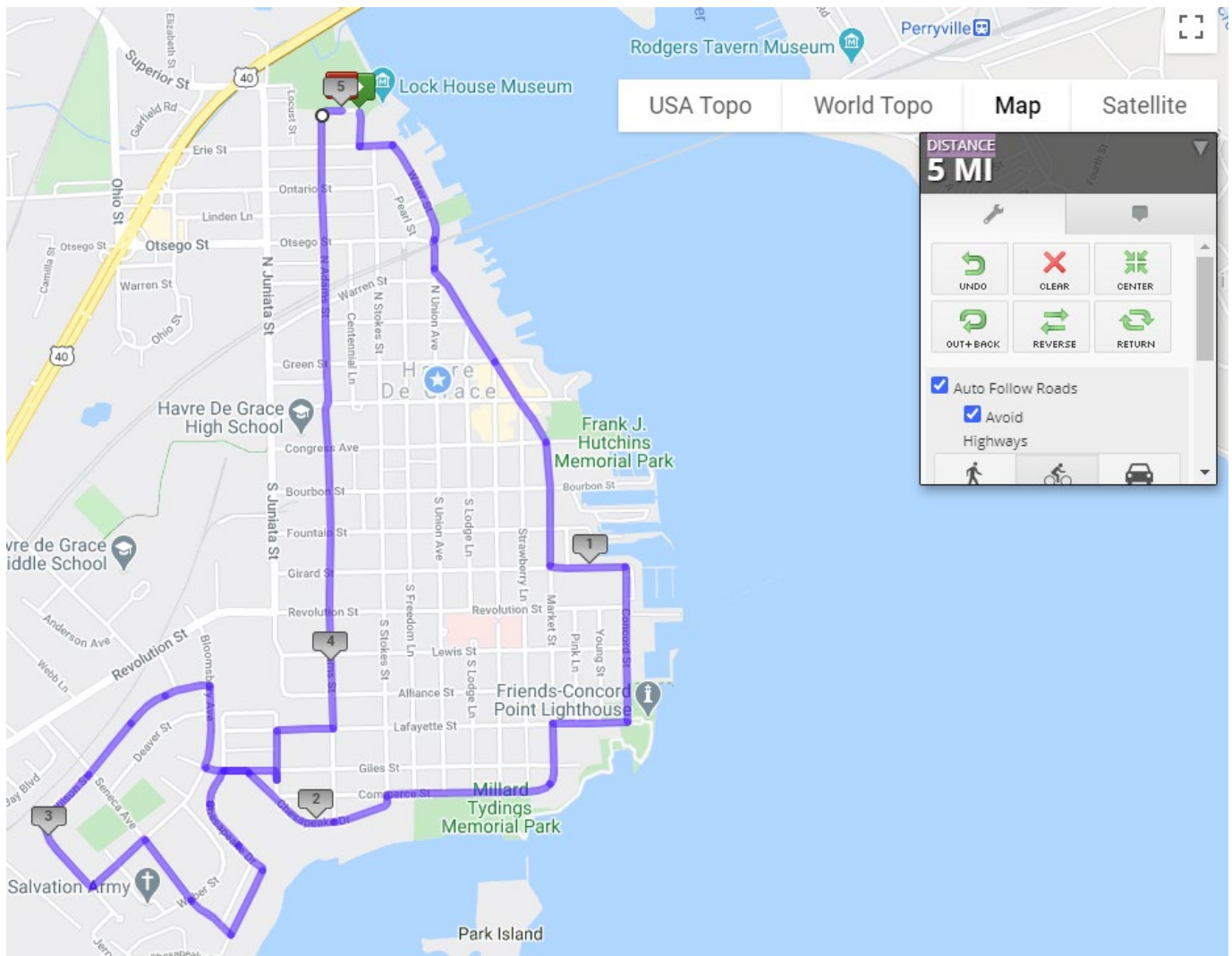

 - Lafayette Trail – 3 mi – City sidewalk
 - North Park Loop/Joe K. Trail – 1-1.5 mi – Railtrail/nature trail
 - Susquehanna State Park – hiking and mountain biking trails
 - Road bike (5 mi example route mapped below)
- ❖ Kayak/paddleboard launch – *please ensure you wear proper water safety gear including lifejackets*
 - Jean Roberts Park
 - Frank J. Hutchins Park
 - Tydings Park
