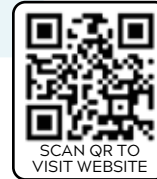

SENECA AVENUE APIARY

Started in 2019, the Apiary supports the endangered pollinator population and is located behind the Seneca Avenue Community Garden. Come see the hard work our second graders from Havre de Grace Elementary School put into painting the beautiful hive boxes.

TODD PARK FOOD FOREST

Started in 2016 and nurtured by food forest volunteers, the Todd Park Food Forest is yielding fruit, nuts, and berries as the plants mature. With our "adopt-a-tree" program anyone can participate, and harvesting the produce is open to the community.

The Heirloom Victory Garden supplements local food pantries with its harvest and exceeded its goal of one thousand pounds of food donated in the first year of growing in 2019.
